REGULATORY ACTIONS REGARDING STANDARDS

Formal Objection to ISO 13485	The Swedish Competent Authority has requested a formal objection be raised by the European Commission to the harmonization of ISO 13485. The Swedish object on several grounds, including that a quality system is not an essential requirement of the MDD and therefore cannot have a harmonized standard, that the standard claims to cover essential requirements that it does not cover, and that in some points the standard is less precise than the directive. The letter sent by the Swedish authority to the EC, and a response from European medical device industry groups are both available on the SoftwareCPR Standards Navigator web page.	
Formal Objection to ISO 14971	A decision on the formal objection to the harmonization of ISO 14971 has been delayed for one year. A task force has recently begun meeting to address the issues that were raised by the EC.
